- Share your feedback with an end of program survey

**Participation Requirements:**

- Desire to build a career in a technology related area
- Are open and interested in interacting with professionals
- Demonstrate a dependable and consistent commitment to communication

**Student Time Commitment:**

- Make a time commitment based on the 2022 -2023 overview >>
- Spend a minimum of a couple of hours a month with a matched professional to maximize your relationship
- Participate in WITonCampus events (if offered at your campus) or participate in regular WIT meetings
